

Charity Commission's report on Regenerations Charities

In 1999 the Charity Commission made a landmark decision to recognise regeneration as a legitimate charitable objective. This report looks at a sample of regeneration charities in detail



The Charity Commission recognised urban & rural regeneration as a charitable purpose in its own right in 1999. This report is the result of research carried out between October 2006 and February 2007 with 50 regeneration charities from a broad geographical spread over England and Wales.

The total annual income of the regeneration charities visited was 41,684,694, total annual expenditure was 35,339,526, and the annual income bracket ranged from 10,000 to 10million.
